BY COMMISSIONER YOUNG: You testified in Bracebridge?

A. Yes.

THE CHAIRMAN: His evidence appears at page 44.

BY MR. MURPHY: Q. You were sent to Miss Caisse's clinic by Dr. William H. Oak? A. Yes, sir.

Q. Of Rosseau? A. Yes, sir.

MR. MURPHY: This letter reads;

Q. Did you have any operation of any kind?

A. None whatsoever.

Q. And you went there -- did you have any other examination beside by Dr. Oak? A. Yes.

Q. By whom else? A. Dr. Lorrie, and Dr. Bowman of Hamilton.

Q. And did they pronounce the same?

A. Yes, told me the same thing, right to my face.

Q. They told you you had carcinoma on the front part of the rectum? A. Yes, 7 inches up.

Q. And what trouble did you have -- pain?

A. After being there, oh, ten months, the pain gradually left me -- it had not left altogether, but it was pretty near gone, and it does not bother me now at all.

BY COMMISSIONER YOUNG: Q. It is still bleeding a little? A. No, none whatsoever.

Q. You were seen, were you, in Bracebridge?

BY COMMISSIONER CALLAHAN: Q. I saw you in Brace-
bridge, A. Yes.

Q. You were having some bleeding? A. Yes.

Q. Not a great deal? A. No.

COMMISSIONER CALLAHAN: I could not reach it. I did
not have a proctoscope.

BY MR. MURPHY: Q. Have you gained in weight?

A. Yes.

Q. How much? A. I lost 16 pounds, and got 5
of it back.

Q. You started to gain when you took Miss Caisse's
treatment? A. Yes. I have been up and
down, and down and up all the time.

BY COMMISSIONER YOUNG: Q. You never had any other
treatment, except that by Miss Caisse? A. None
whatsoever.

BY COMMISSIONER VALIN: Q. That is about one year
ago? A. It will be a year next August. I
started on the 20th of August.

BY MR. MURPHY: Q. A Year next month? A. Yes.

BY COMMISSIONER CALLAHAN: Q. Did you see anybody
since we were up there in February? A. No.

Q. You had no further examination? A. No. *Mark*

BY COMMISSIONER WALLACE: You have continued
the treatments since that time? A. Yes.
